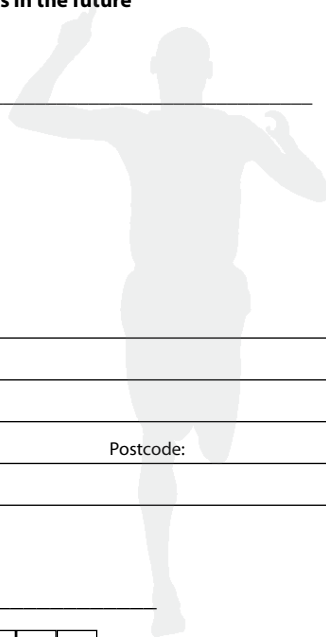

Now you're signed up here is what to expect

The Teams – teams should ideally be mixed and include up to 10 people. The games have been designed so that all abilities can enjoy them and no one will be forced to take part in games if they do not wish to. Please ensure that you bring a towel and change of clothes as you will get wet – it is all part of the fun. The venue will have ample shower and changing facilities for you.

Team briefing – Teams should arrive at least 30 minutes before start time. It is compulsory for all participants to attend the safety briefing and the compere will also explain the event format.

The Games – All games will be relay based in which one or two people perform a task at a time. For example, you may have to retrieve giant jigsaw pieces by going over an inflatable. The team who completes the jigsaw first wins. In all the games the whole team takes part and co-ordination and co-operation are essential.

The event will last approximately 3 hours.

Safety – Although the games are designed to be fun, Gable Events take safety seriously. Participants must remove all jewellery and should consult the paramedic on the day about any injury concerns. Food, drink and smoking are strictly prohibited in the games arena.

Facilities – there will be a cash bar and bbq running throughout the day so no need to worry about being hungry or thirsty. There is plenty of space for family and friends to cheer you on.

Scoring – 40 points are awarded for a win on each game with 30 for a draw and even 20 for losing.

Playing your joker – You can choose one game to play your joker on before the game commences. This doubles your points on that game. Simply tell the referee before your chosen game starts.

Extra points – Extra points are also often awarded for the best dressed team, best joker, best behaved team and the team raising the most money.

Lots and lots of fun!!! – The main emphasis of the day is to be fun and raise lots of money for Bridge2Aid.
